The 10th hole was routinely halved with 2 putt pars. Phil halved the 11th hole as he was able to get up and down from the front left bunker, while Ray's 20 foot birdie putt missed by inches, leaving a tap in for par. The 13th was halved as well, as Pete's 10 foot birdie putt was left just short of the hole. First blood was drawn on 13, when Matt left his fairway bunker shot short and right of the green, but holed his chip shot for birdie, giving his team a one up advantage. Pete and Ray mutually conceded short birdie putts on 14 to keep the score the same, and the 15th was halved with 2 putt pars. On 16, only Pete was able to hit his approach shot inside the temporary green circle, giving him the hole and drawing his team even. Phil proved prescient on 17, when he advised Matt that his rather short tee shot only made it a three shot hole, an advice that Matt heeded when he chipped his third shot stiff to the pin for a hole winning par, giving his team a one hole lead with just one to play. But Phil and Pete were up to the task, as they parred the 18th to square the match. So the first match of the 2007 season ended in a draw, with no points for any of the players.
