The opening hole was halved when Phil was able to get up and down from beyond the greenside bunker on the left and both Ray and Pete two putted for par. After being granted relief from the temporary lake in the bottom of the far right trap on 11, Ray flopped a beautiful chip just past the hole and made an uphill two footer for par to win the hole. Matt's tee shot on 12 ended up next to the porta-potty in the left side woods, but his "shot of the day" punched five iron through the trees found the green. He and Ray both two putted for par to halve the hole and leave Pete/Ray one up. On 13, Matt was the only one able to find the green in two, and even though he missed his birdie putt, par was good enough to win the hole and square the match. Ray and Matt again had birdie putts, this time on 14, but both two putted for par. All four players found the green with their tee shots on 15, but when nobody made birdie the match remained even. The turning point of the day was 16, as only Pete was able to stay inside the temporary circle and make par and the momentum was with his team as they took a 1-up lead. This proved critical as Pete smoked a five wood just over the green on the 17th and was then able to get up and down from the far fringe to win the hole and close out the match. First blood of the season to Pete and Ray.

Shot of the Day- Turning a sow's ear into milk, Matt made up for his errant tee shot on 12 which found the woods and outhouse when he punched and ran a 5 iron through the trees and onto the green, giving him a birdie opportunity from about 10-12 feet (which he missed).
