Sunday saw one of the usual pairings, same as vesterday, with Phil and Pete against Ray and Matt. Pete and Matt hit long drives on the tenth, but Matt's found the bunker while Pete was in the fairway. Pete left himself about six feet for birdie, and even though he could not convert, his par was sufficient to win the hole and put his team one up right away. It seemed like this might be a repeat of Saturday's wipeout, but the tide would turn quickly beginning on eleven, where Matt saved par from the left side bunker with a high flop shot and putt to halve the match. Phil noted that the twelfth tee would be the first time that Ray and Matt had honors in ten holes over two days, and while that did not qualify for a coveted "Quote of the Day", it may have supplied just the right motivation and impetus to his opponents. Matt and Pete were down the middle on twelve, with Pete finding the soggy turf in front of the green with his approach and Matt hitting above the hole by twelve feet. Matt made his putt for birdie to win the hole and put his team in the lead. The thirteenth hole had Ray and Pete long and in the fairway, with Matt in the first fairway bunker. But Matt was able to hit the green with his shot from the sand and two putted for par to win the hole and give his team a two hole lead. On the fourteenth hole, both Ray and Pete were penalized after good tee shots....Ray unable to find his ball on the left edge while Pete was on the side of the grass bunker, needing a baseball swing to move forward. Matt took advantage of the situation as he hit his approach shot from about 110 yards to the middle of the green and made par to win that hole. Pete and Ray were on the fifteenth green from the tee, but neither could make his birdie putt and the hole was halved, leaving Ray and Matt three up with three to go as they trudged up the hill. Ray hit a beautiful approach shot to the sixteenth and a two putt par was sufficient to tie Pete, halve the hole, and give his team the victory...three and two.
