

Matt hit a fairway metal short of the trap, and although he mishit his approach shot he was able to get up and down for par to win the hole, as both Pete and Ray had trouble in the left side trees. Phil was the only player on the green on the eleventh, while both Matt and Ray needed chip shots to get to the putting surface. But all made their pars and the hole was halved. Matt and Phil both found trouble on twelve, while Pete was long and in the fairway and Ray hit an approach shot to about ten feet. Pete made his par, enough to win the hole, but Ray went one better and sank his birdie putt to even the match. Ray and Matt both found sand on the thirteenth, Matt driving into the fairway bunker and Ray hitting his second shot into the greenside bunker. Ray made a twisting downhill putt and Matt made an easier uphill putt to halve the hole. Ray hit driver with the tees far up on the short par five fourteenth and was able to make a rather routine par, which was not matched by the other players, so Ray won the hole and gave his team their first lead of the day. The "chipper" lived up to his nickname on fifteen, chipping from off the green to save par and win the hole for his team. The sixteenth hole was horrible for everyone, so bad that Ray's bogey won the hole and gave his team a lead yet again. Matt was on the right side of the seventeenth fairway and hit a nice second shot, but it stayed right and ended up in the greenside bunker. From there he almost holed a sand shot, but ran about eight feet past the cup, was able to make the comeback putt for par to win the hole and the match was square with one to go. Pete and Ray were both in trouble off the tee on eighteen while Phil was in the middle of the fairway and Matt was on the right side. Both players hit their approach shots onto the green, Phil two putted for par to guarantee a tie even if Ray were to make his par putt, and Matt followed by sinking his birdie putt to win the hole and end the match.
