I forgot to bring my voice recorder for the Sunday match on November 22, but Phil saved that day with the following recollection that he sent to me the following day:

Here's my recall

10 Matt and Pete halved with birdies

11 Phil won with par

12 halved

13 halved

14 Ray won with birdie

15 Pete won with par

16 halved

17 Pete/Ray won hole to win match by 2-1 score.

18 exhibition hole Phil put a 9 iron to 2 inches.

Highlights:

First time I recall that all 4 of us had a birdie in 9 holes.

Shot of the day. Toss up between your putt on 10; Pete's wedge on 10 and Ray's iron on 14. Your call. Since it is "my call", I will immediately eliminate my putt on the tenth hole. While it was some pressure to halve the hole, I don't think a three or four foot putt can ever qualify as a great shot. Between the other two, I am selecting Ray's approach shot on fourteen....longer than Pete's approach on 10, totally blind to an elevated green. Congratulation to Ray.

Quote of day Ray's comment after hearing about my tap in birdie on 18.

"Too little too late." I have to admit that I did not hear this, so without Phil's recap this bit of wit would have been lost.
