Pete just missed a six foot birdie putt and Matt made his from inside two feet to get his team back in the game, one down. The thirteenth was sloppy, and Ray and Matt halved the hole with bogey. The same was true on the fourteenth hole when neither Ray nor Matt could make par from 100 yards out in two, so bogeys halved again. Pete saved a wonderful par on fifteen when he made a comeback putt from the back fringe, but it was not enough as Matt hit a nice seven iron to about ten feet and made another birdie. The match was tied going up the hill. Matt was in the fairway but left his approach shot short of the green, then got up and down for a saving par. It turned out to be enough to win the hole when Pete could not convert and Phil and Matt had their first lead of the day. All four players hit nice tee shots on seventeen, with Phil the longest down the middle. Pete and Matt missed right, Phil and Ray were short, but Matt got up and down from the right side to save par and win the hole, closing out the match, two and one.
