But neither player could make their birdie and Phil masterfully two putted from the back fringe to halve the hole. Nobody made the eleventh green, and Matt ended up playing the wrong ball from near the fence and was disqualified from the hole. The other players all made bogey and the match remained even. Ray was on the twelfth in regulation and even though his birdie putt missed the cup, his par was enough to win the hole. Matt, Ray and Pete were in the fairway on thirteen but Matt had the best angle from the right side of the fairway and was able to hit his trusted hybrid onto the green and make par to win the hole and square the match. Ray and Pete played the fourteenth routinely, both setting on the back right side of the green in regulation and two putted for par to win the hole. The same outcome on sixteen, Ray and Pete on the green in regulation and two putts for par, and they took a two hole lead going up the hill. Almost the same outcome on sixteen, Ray and Pete on the green in regulation, but this time Pete sank his twelve foot birdie putt to win the hole and close out the match....three and two.
