Phil looked like he sprayed his approach shot to the right but kicked toward the green and he was able to save par with a nice chip and putt. Ray two putted to match and Matt's long birdie putt came up wide so the match was even through one. Ray and Matt both hit nice shots on eleven, Matt just on the fringe to the right with Ray on the green...two putts from each to halve the hole and keep the match even. The twelfth hole was halved with four fairly boring pars, the only excitement being the bounce that Pete's errant tee shot took to get back to the fairway. The first lead of the day came on thirteen when Pete missed the green and settled for bogey while Matt hit the green with a hybrid and two putted for par and a lead. The lead was short lived when Matt could not flop his shot from the rear of the green to save par, while Pete was on the green in regulation and, even though he missed his birdie, made par to halve the match. Ray and Pete were both on the green on fifteen, two putts for par, which gave them the hole when both Phil and Matt missed the green and made bogey. The sixteenth hole was halved with pars by all players, Ray from the fairway bunker, Pete routinely two putting and Phil saving his hole with a low running approach shot and a nice chip. Matt and Pete were off to the right of the green on seventeen, Matt flubbing his chip and landing in the sand while Pete safely went past the cup and onto the green. Meanwhile, Ray was in the sand and came out to about ten feet, stroked his par putt for his second sandie in a row to win the hole. The match was virtually closed out at this point, but sealed when both Matt and Phil lost their tee shots on eighteen to the right while Ray was right down the middle and long. Phil came back with a par save, but it was too little and too late as Ray also made par and his team won the match by two strokes and made him the new leader.

SHOT OF THE DAY: Today's award is for a group of shots from the sand by Ray on the sixteenth and seventeenth holes. From the fairway bunker on sixteen, Ray hit a hybrid high but to the right and it found the greenside bunker, but he was able to blast out nicely and save his par to win the hole. Again in the greenside bunker on the difficult seventeenth, Ray again blasted out and made his par-saving putt to win the hole.
