Both hit seven irons to the green, Pete stopping short and needing to chip while Matt hopped past the cup. Two shots later from each, the hole was tied and we moved to seventeen. Balls in the fairway on seventeen, Ray with the longest shot and he hit his to the rough short of the green. Matt with a hybrid that stopped pin high but two feet off the right side and Pete hit five wood to the front edge. Ray sank his par putt first after a nice flop shot, followed by Matt stopping his putt from off the green a few inches away from the hole and they won the hole when Pete admittedly pulled his first putt of the day. The match was closed out on eighteen after Ray hit the green in regulation and Phil could not repeat his heroics of a couple of weeks ago with a fifty foot putt.
