Sunday of Labor Day weekend was even better weather than Saturday, temperatures in the high 50s because of a cool wind blowing, but the sun was shining. Ray showed up wearing pastels in honor of the end of summer and his upcoming cruise to the beautiful island of Bermuda, and Pete donated a pink golf ball to Ray for the day. Pete and Matt were teamed together, facing Phil and Ray. Matt and Phil were in the fairway on ten, Ray just in the rough, and all three hit very nice approach shots that stopped within eight feet of the hole for three legitimate birdie chances. But only Ray could convert, sinking his first putt of the day with the Pink Lady, to take the early lead. Matt and Pete came back on eleven when Matt two putted from the left side for par to win the hole. Nobody found the fairway on twelve and only Ray could get onto the green, but Matt punched out of the woods toward the front of the green and made a twelve foot putt to save his par and win that hole. There were many issues on the thirteenth hole for all the players and bogeys halved the hole, leaving Pete and Matt one up. More trouble for everyone on fourteen, Ray losing two balls and Phil losing one, Pete landing in the right-side hazard and Matt hitting a poor tee shot. But Matt recovered best, flopping a wedge from the front hill and hitting a curling downhill three footer to again save par and win the hole. Pete was just on the right edge of the fifteenth hole after a good bounce and Ray was on the edge of the green after using his "ninety nine" into the wind, both players two putted for par and the hole was halved. The match ended without drama on sixteen after Phil was in trouble and Ray landed between two rocks on the left, while Pete had an eight iron to the green from the fairway. Although he missed the green, Pete got up and down for par to win the hole and close the match...three and two.

**STORY LINE TO BE FOLLOWED-** Ray decided to stop using the pink ball after his birdie on ten, claiming he did not know the distances the ball would travel. But after the match ended on sixteen, Ray brought the Pink Lady back and proceeded to par the difficult seventeenth and then top that by chipping in for birdie from behind the trap on eighteen.
