A foggy morning for the new start times, people teeing off at 6:22 on the Memorial Day weekend, and the group was second behind Dave's group, who was playing an extra round for the three day holiday. Pete and Ray were to take on Phil and Matt in a traditional match play format, but before the match there was a note of celebrity and accomplishment to be acknowledged when the others found out about Phil's qualification for the Metropolitan Golf Association member-member better ball tournament, chosen to represent the Griff with his partner, Al Major, in upcoming events. It turns out that Phil's team, needing a birdie on eighteen to clinch the local gualifying, turned to its newest player and were not disappointed after Phil nailed a beautiful approach shot from under the right side trees to six feet on the final hole, and calmly sank his putt for the local victory. Good luck to our local heroes as they carry our good name forward to the next round. To start today's match, both Pete and Matt hooked their tee shots to the cart path on eighteen and had to come over the trees toward their own green. But both were successful, Pete landing on the fringe and two putting for his par while Matt found the short grass on the green and also two putted. Phil was the only player on the eleventh green but on the front portion with a yellow flag, leaving himself a twenty-five foot putt. It turned out that Phil would need to two putts just to halve the hole after Ray came out of the left side bunker to about a foot and was conceded his par. Matt had the best drive on twelve but the old demons showed their ugly head when he mishit (euphemism....can't use the "s" word") his approach. Meanwhile both Ray and Pete were within ten feet on their approaches and although neither could capitalize on birdie, par was sufficient to win the hole and give that team the early lead. Ray hit a beautiful hybrid from the fairway to the fringe on thirteen, left his uphill putt just outside the cup but tapped in for par and another hole won.
