
## 2011 GRIFFITH HARRIS EARLY-BIRD BACK-NINE CHAMPIONSHIP

Sunday was the first time the group would play the SKINS game, the first time that individual competition would be the format for the players. The rules were discussed at the tenth tee and the group settled into the third tee time on a cool and brisk morning. Pete and Phil pulled their opening tee shots to the left while Matt and Ray were straighter, Ray dead center in the fairway. But Pete was the only player able to make par after he lobbed an approach shot over the trees and onto the green, two putting for his par and the first skin. Ray was the only player to find the eleventh green from the tee but he had a fifty-foot uphill putt to contend with. Meanwhile Matt was a couple of feet onto the right side fringe, and when his chip settled within a foot of the cup for a tap in par, he was able to take the hole and the second skin. Nice drives on twelve, Pete and Ray onto the back right side of the green and only Ray able to convert for par...another sloppy hole but a first skin for Ray. Ray got a huge bounce off the road on thirteen but settled under low hanging trees that impacted his approach shot. Matt and Pete were off to the right side of the fairway and had about 150 yards for their approach shots. Pete hit the better of the approach shots, leaving himself about eight feet while Matt was just off the green with a sideways putt. Pete easily two putted while Matt ran his first putt ten feet below the cup, but stroked the uphill comeback into the cup to save par and tie the hole, carrying over the first skin to the par five fourteenth. Phil hit a beautiful drive on fourteen but was unlucky to catch the edge of the hill for a severe downhill lie for his second, recovered nicely with a good approach toward the creek and then a very nice wedge to birdie distance on the green. Meanwhile, Pete bounced off the trees on the right and back toward the fairway to even have a second shot, bounced off the trees and the rocks with the second but landed in the fairway, and then a screaming hybrid into the uphill turf that stopped on the back of the green. Both players two putted for par, different methods but the same score, and another carryover to the next hole. Phil hit a six iron to the fringe on fifteen while Pete and Ray both found the trap and Matt found the fourteenth hole again. Only Phil could save his par, chipping and a putt later, to win the first multiple skins of the season and give himself a nice lead heading up the hill. Nobody could save par on sixteen, so bogeys halved the hole and made the seventeenth worth two skins. Matt and Pete were down the fairway but a long way from the hole into a significant wind, and while both hit straight approach shots neither reached the putting surface. Both chipped but missed par opportunities, so the hole was halved and eighteen would be worth three skins. Phil needed any tie on eighteen to preserve his victory for the day, while the other three players entered with one skin and the chance to win the day with a win on the last hole. Pete and Matt were down the middle, Phil to the right and Ray in trouble on the left. Phil hit a nice approach shot to twenty-five feet while Pete and Matt both hit shorter wedges to about ten feet. Phil tried to close out the match with his birdie attempt, and although it was close it skimmed the hole and Phil settled for par and a hope that neither Pete nor Matt (or even both, forcing a tie) would make their putts. After a narrow choice of who was away. Pete putted first and missed his birdie attempt, but Matt stroked his into the center of the cup and stole the three skins and victory.
