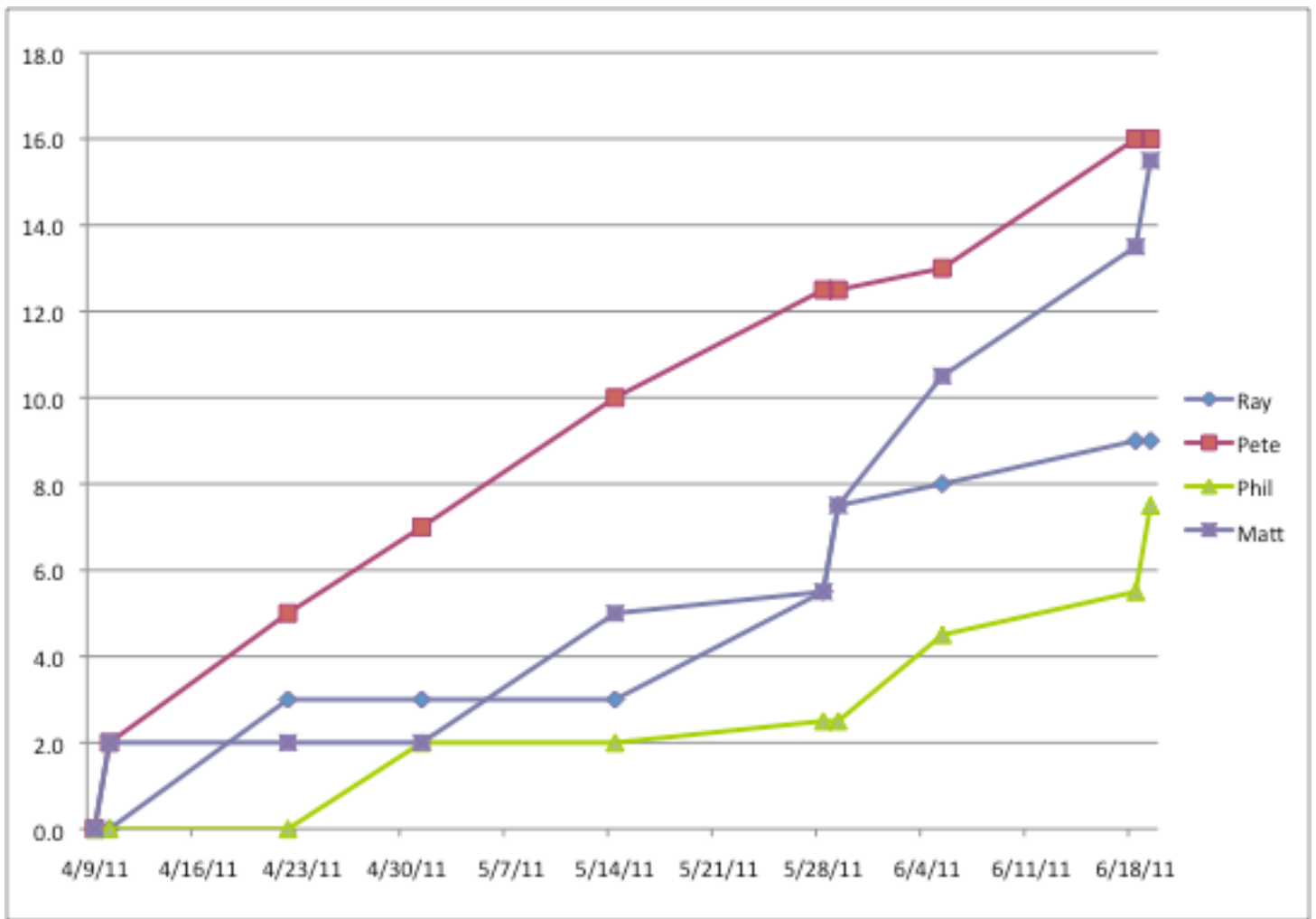


2011 GRIFFITH HARRIS EARLY-BIRD BACK-NINE CHAMPIONSHIP

Fathers' Day Sunday brought a medal match pairing Phil with Matt against Ray and Pete. Phil was a bit left off the tenth tee while the other three were in the fairway, pleasing Jack immensely. Matt hit the first approach shot and lobbed a wedge to about six feet and Pete was up to the pressure when he landed his wedge just outside of Matt's distance. Ray got down in two putts from a good distance, giving Pete a shot at birdie, but his putt lipped out on the high side and spun out for par. Matt gave his team the early lead after he made his birdie putt for a three. Nobody found the eleventh green from the tee but Phil hit a beautiful chip over the left side bunker that stopped about three feet from the cup, and his par saving putt gave his team another shot added to their lead. Pete and Ray were in the middle of the twelfth fairway while Matt was longer down the left side. Ray and Pete both hit good wedges and had birdie opportunities while Matt mishit his approach and was in the front fringe. But Matt came back with a chip to within inches for a par save and when Ray was short and Pete again lipped out, pars tied the hole. Momentum appeared to begin to change on thirteen after Pete hit a great seven iron to the green that stopped about five feet from the cup. The best anyone else could do was double bogey so even though Pete could not convert his birdie (another putt on the edge), he gave his team a two stroke advantage and tied the match. That momentum carried over to Pete's partner on the fourteenth when Ray hit a beautiful approach shot from about 130 yards, was on the green in regulation and made his par, while neither Matt nor Phil could get up and down to save theirs. The lead had changed hands, Pete and Ray one stroke up. But momentum shifted again on fifteen, Phil hitting the best tee shot and leaving himself about a fifteen foot birdie putt while the opponents were in trouble. Phil's birdie putt was irrelevant, though, after Matt chipped in from the longer greenside grass for a birdie and the team gained two shots after neither Pete nor Ray could salvage their pars. Phil and Matt were one stroke up going up the hill. The sixteenth hole was not well played by anyone and bogeys tied the hole and kept the lead at one stroke. Ray and Matt both missed their approach shots on seventeen to the right side while Phil was to the left. Ray hit the best wedge and stayed above the hole, Phil on the front of the green and Matt behind the hole with no easy putts to be had. Everyone two putted for bogey, the hole was tied and the one shot lead was intact going to eighteen. Pete and Matt were long in the fairway, Phil also in the short grass but a bit longer and Ray was in trouble on the left. Phil found the bunker, leaving the hole to Pete and Matt to decide. Pete hit his approach shot to the front of the green, stopping on the fringe with a red flag, while Matt landed pin high and eight feet to the right. Pete just missed his putt and settled for par, leaving Matt two putts to tie the hole and win the match. But Matt made his third birdie of the day when he sank his putt in the right side and Phil and Matt closed out the match with a two stroke victory.
