
2011 GRIFFITH HARRIS EARLY-BIRD BACK-NINE CHAMPIONSHIP

A much better day on Sunday, bright and clear and ready to go with a medal match pitting Ray and Phil against Pete and Matt. Jack challenged and goaded the group, as usual, on the tenth tee and the results were good as Ray, Pete and Matt all hit the fairway with their tee shots. Matt had "difficulties" on his second shot but Pete and Ray both hit beautiful wedges to within ten feet of the cup and had reasonable birdie putts. After determining that Ray was away by the slightest of margins, both players gave it good runs and missed birdies by about an inch, and pars halved the hole. Phil hit the best tee shot on eleven, pin high above the hole with a downhill putt while Matt and Ray were short and left. Matt chipped to eighteen inches, Ray to two feet and both saved par so when Phil's birdie putt slid just by the side of the cup the hole was again halved. Pete's tee shot on twelve bounced off the trees and landed at the top of the hill but in the fairway. From there he landed his second shot on the thirteenth tee, but he saved his perfect shot for the right time when he lobbed a wedge that stopped about a foot from the cup for par. Meanwhile Ray played more conventionally and had a ten foot birdie putt which was read by both teammates, a trend that would continue throughout the round. The putt just missed the cup, par was conceded and the match remained even through three. Matt was long in the fairway on thirteen, Ray a bit shorter and hit first. His hybrid was the right club, right distance and stopped on the right side fringe. Matt hit an iron, not brimming with confidence, but managed to get it to the rough on the side of the green. Matt's chip was close enough to the hole to be conceded and Ray's two putts were good for four as well. Drives were down the middle on fourteen but everyone pulled their second shots toward the left side trees. Ray still managed to hit a nice approach shot to the right side and stopped on the fringe with a very long putt. Matt hit a very nice flop shot from the front slope and made his seven footer to save par, matching Ray who made a nice second putt for his par as well. The match was still tied, all pars on all holes. Pete was on the right side of the fifteenth green with a long putt, Phil in the middle of the green and Ray off the front. Only Pete saved par with a nice second putt of four feet and the first advantage of the day went to Pete and Matt. Pete and Ray hit gorgeous approach shots on sixteen but both had slippery putts for birdie, and equally slippery putts to save par...both up to the task, both made par and tied the hole. Matt hit his tee shot far left on seventeen and thought his ball was lost until he almost stepped on it under a broad leaf weed, while Pete hit off a tree on the right side and was in the rough. Both approached short of the green as did Ray after a good tee shot, but nobody could save par and all settled for bogey and another tie, leaving Matt and Pete with a one shot advantage going to eighteen. Both Pete and Matt hit good tee shots on eighteen, Pete a bit to the right and Matt in the fairway, putting pressure on Phil and Ray who needed to win the hole. After both Pete and Matt landed their approach shots on the green, the match was all but over, and when both made par the players all shook hands after a good match, close all the way and well contested.
