

The day was sunny and pleasant when the group teed off at 6:22 for a medal match pitting Pete and Phil against Ray and Matt. Phil started out in the fairway, Ray to the right and Pete and Matt heading left. Pete and Phil both went past the hole with their approaches and had fifteen foot birdie putts, while Matt had a bit shorter putt from the front side of the green. All three putts narrowly missed and tap in pars halved the hole with fours. Nobody hit the eleventh green from the tee, Pete getting his first big bounce off the right side trees and into the middle of the fairway while Phil was off the front and Matt and Ray were off the far left. Phil and Pete chipped but could not save par, while Ray chipped below the hole land Matt to the side, both dropping their putts to make par and take the lead. Matt was long in the fairway on twelve and Pete got his second big bounce off a tree on the left side to end up in the rough rather than on the fifteenth tee box, Phil shorter in the fairway after hitting fairway wood from the tee and Ray was in the rough. Phil hit a nice approach to the green and Pete curved a low shot that stopped off the right edge and both made par. Meanwhile Ray and Matt both were short of the green but saved their pars as well to tie the hole and maintain a one shot advantage. Pete hit a nice drive down the left side of the fairway while Ray and Matt were to the right. Pete was on the back edge of the green after a good approach and both Ray and Matt missed the green and stopped in the rough. They chipped to makeable distances and watched as Pete rolled a thirty foot curling putt to about three feet. Ray missed his uphill putt and Matt slid a sidehill putt past the hole as well, and after Pete knocked in his curvy second putt for par, his team won the hole and tied the match. Everyone missed their approach shots on fourteen, Pete and Phil short and Ray and Matt to the right. Ray made the best chip to five feet and the only putt to drop for par, winning the hole and regaining the lead for his team. Ray hit a beautiful seven iron on fifteen, leaving himself a birdie opportunity under pressure after Matt hit his tee shot onto the fourteenth. Pete and Phil both were left off the hill, but Pete was able to chip nicely and save par, and when Ray's birdie putt slid past the right side of the cup, pars tied the hole. The big swing came on sixteen with Ray nailing a gorgeous iron into the green and stopping six feet from the cup while both Phil and Pete had trouble. The best Pete could do was bogey from the greenside bunker, leaving Ray a golden opportunity for a two shot swing if he could make his birdie putt....which, of course, he did, the pressure never bothering him. Ray and Matt took a three shot lead into seventeen. Ray hit a very atypical tee shot on seventeen, rolling into the thick rough just in front of the tee box. It looked like Matt had to salvage the hole and he hit a nice drive in the fairway. But it was Ray who saved the day with a hybrid out of the thick stuff and a fairway wood to the green, two putts for bogey. That tied the hole after Phil and Pete both chipped onto the green but could not save par with long putts. The three shot advantage remained, and the match was conceded....and a one hole press match started on eighteen. Ray was the only player in the fairway on eighteen but it looked like Pete would save his team when he hit an approach shot to the edge of the green and stroked his approach putt to tap in distance, making par. Ray had a chance to win, a birdie putt from twelve feet...and of course, he made the putt to win the press and give his team another point.
