Two matches in two days in a single weekend.....priceless. The weather was crisp with some wind as the group teed off on Sunday in a medal play format pitting Pete and Phil against Ray and Matt. Three drives went down the fairway on ten, Pete and Phil playing partner golf down the left side, but Ray sprayed his tee shot into the woods on the right, prompting Jack to suggest that Ray get in the cart and grab a ride to his ball. Phil and Pete both found the fringe and Ray went too long and into the trap, leaving Matt the only player on the green in regulation and two putts for par to take an early one stroke lead. Matt and Phil were left on eleven, Pete on the green past the hole and Ray about six feet above the hole. Matt lobbed a chip to a foot and was given his par, Pete putted four feet past the cup but made a good comeback for his three and Ray gave it a good attempt when he was just off the edge of the cup...pars halving the hole. Pete was right on twelve, Phil to the left and Ray and Matt in the fairway. Pete hit a nice iron onto the green about twenty feet from the hole, Ray landed just off the back edge and Matt was on the front side. Ray putted first and rolled a beautiful downhill shot that stopped a foot away from the cup, followed by Pete stopping two feet away and Matt also two putting for par, keeping the one stroke advantage for Ray and Matt. Pete, Ray and Matt were all on the fairway on thirteen with Pete hitting the best shot to the green, past the pin and leaving a long curling putt, while both Ray and Matt missed the green. Pete did well to two putt and make his par, winning the hole and gaining back the stroke when neither Ray nor Matt could get up and down. All even. All players had a chance to be on the fourteenth in regulation, but only Ray finished the effort when his approach went above the hole. Pete landed his approach short on the edge of the slope, chipped uphill to about a foot for his par, which halved the hole after Ray rolled a downhill putt past the cup and made the comeback for par as well. Ray and Pete were on the fifteenth green, Matt long and Phil to the right where his ball disappeared into the trailing group. Both Ray and Pete made routine two putt pars to keep the match even going up the hill. Pete bounced into the fairway bunker on the right side of sixteen, Ray and Matt both in the fairway for approach shots. Pete's shot was pulled into the next bunker, Ray was on the edge and Matt landed pin high to the right. Pete hit a nice bunker shot but it ran down the slope and he settled for bogey, while Matt rolled a good birdie attempt right of the hole and tapped in for par, his team taking a one shot lead. All four balls were in the fairway on seventeen and Ray had the best approach shot by landing a long fairway metal on the front edge of the green. Phil and Matt were to the right, Pete a bit left and short. After Matt hit a wedge left, he made a long par saving putt that bounced along and into the cup. Ray gave his long putt a good run and also made par, while Pete had to putt back toward the hole after his chip and could not save his four. The lead was two going to the last hole. Ray was in the fairway and a bit short, Pete and Matt longer with good approach shots. All three hit onto the green, right of the hole, and had twenty plus foot birdie putts. Ray went first and left his first putt just over a foot from the cup, his par given to him by the opponents that ended the match. Pete and Matt also made par to keep the final advantage at two strokes.
