

Sunday, October 27

A chilly day, not as cold as Saturday so no frost delay, but definitely autumn weather golf as the group engaged in a Skins format match. Pete borrowed a Ping G-25 driver from Matt, a good choice as the final score for the day would indicate. He started with a long drive in the center of the fairway, past another good tee shot from Phil. Matt was wide to the right but fortunate to go completely through the trees, and Ray was in decent position as well. Phil hit the best approach, a wedge to eleven or twelve feet, while the opponents all had much work to do. They all came up short for birdie, got their fours and watched as Phil stroked his putt over the front edge for the first skin and an early lead. Matt and Ray were off to the right on eleven, Pete left on the hard dirt surface and Phil off the green as well. Phil hit a good chip past the hole, Ray also a good shot below the hole and Pete with a remarkable shot off the hard pan to above the hole. He stroked a good putt to save his par, pressure on Ray to match, which he did with a good stroke to carry one skin over to twelve. Pete was fortunate to get a big right bounce off a tree on twelve, stopping in the fairway, and he took advantage of the situation with a good shot to the green and a two-putt par to win the hole after the opponents all found their own problems along the way. Two skins for Pete. Phil hit a good tee shot on thirteen but found trouble and lost his ball on the approach. Pete and Ray could not make the green in two, Pete in the left side shrubs and Ray short. Matt was also short after a long tee shot, but he managed to keep his chip below the hole, a better spot to save par. After the others slid their putts past the hole, Matt made the uphill putt for his four and a skin. The fourteenth hole was well played, differently among the group. Phil mishit his second shot but recovered well and had a stroke to play with, reaching the approach area in net two. Ray hit a good second shot that stopped in the rough, and Pete also hit a good second after his tee shot was lost in plain sight and he was given a replacement. Matt hit driver from the tee and saw his shot go down the hill, the best of the group. He took aim at the green and had the right distance but was off the left side of the green in two. On approach shots, Phil was right of the pin and about twenty feet from the cup, Ray to the back of the green and Ray to the side. Matt's chip went about five feet from the cup and it looked like he would win another skin with a birdie. Pete and Ray could not make their birdies, but Phil stroked a beauty from the right side that found him striding toward the cup as the ball was en route, dead center for his birdie. That made Matt's putt a necessity to just tie the hole, no skin available for him. He made his birdie, tied Phil's four and carried the skin to the par three fifteenth. Work was being done on the fifteenth tee box, so the blue blocks were set up just more than one hundred yards from the red pin. Phil hit a good wedge but just caught the edge of the slope and ended up in the bunker. Matt took out his thirty one degree hybrid, no concession to the shorter distance, and got his shot high in the air and right of the pin by ten feet. Ray was straight but long, and Pete was to the left. Both players made good lag putts that assured their pars, and when Matt's putt stayed out of the hole by perhaps half an inch, the hole was tied and another skin carried. The sixteenth was poorly played across the board, with balls out of bounds and finding bunkers along the way, and Ray and Matt tied the hole with bogeys. The seventeenth was well played by contrast, Matt being the only player to miss the fairway and needing to chip out. Phil hit a very good second shot down to the cart signs, lying net one at that point. Pete was close to Phil in two and Ray went through the green from two hundred yards, stopping on the left edge in two. Matt's hybrid stopped next to Ray so they had similar chips but different stroke counts. Phil hit a good chip and took two putts for a net par, and although Matt almost holed his chip for par, it was Ray's up and down that saved his four and tied the hole. We went to eighteen with the knowledge that the winner of that hole would prevail for the day. Three excellent drives on eighteen gave Phil, Ray and Matt good chances for birdie. Matt pulled his shot into the trap but Pete and Ray hit good approach shots to reasonable distances. Unfortunately neither could make their three and settled for fours, tying the hole and giving the day's match to Pete with two skins, followed by Phil and Matt with one each.
